- Online Risk-taking behaviours
- Risk-taking behaviours with vaping and/or nicotine-based product use

These workshops align with healthy relationships messaging and explore the 'risk – consequence – regret' framework to build insight, responsibility and better decision-making.

WORKSHOP FORMAT

- Two x 60-minute online sessions
- Delivered three weeks apart
- Small group, deeper-dive format
- Designed as an alternative to suspension or expulsion
- Attendance must be voluntary
- Students attend with a parent/carer, or as part of a small school-supported group
