



VAPING, LET'S CLEAR THE AIR

Supporting young people around risk-taking behaviours requires more than one approach. These workshops bring together education, prevention and practical strategies to strengthen school and family responses to vaping and nicotine use.

Originally developed through a two-year community-informed project across 10 local government areas, this series has now expanded to address both vaping and nicotine products.

The workshops were highly received and are now available for booking in 2026 as fee-for-service through BATForce.

WORKSHOP OPTIONS

Student Workshop (Years 5–10): Age-appropriate education on vaping and nicotine products.

Parent & Carer Community Workshop: Clear, practical guidance for supporting young people at home.

Professional Development for Schools & Community Agencies: Up-to-date information and strategies to strengthen whole-school/community responses.

Diversion Workshop (Targeted Small Groups): For families or groups where vaping/nicotine use has become problematic or is impacting school engagement.
